Ground West and 1 West Office Renovations, Herbert R. Temple JR. Army National Guard Readiness Center, Arlington, VA

GbOSS accomplished this \$2.3 MM office renovation in five phases, ensuring no service disruptions and maintaining full operations of building activities. Work included adding break rooms, conference rooms. moving partition walls, drywall work, accoustical ceiling tiles, flooring, cove base, painting/staining, chair rail, signage, window glazing and floor box moves. Work was performed in a fully occupied building and protocols were employed to ensure pedestrian safety.



P20HQ Mitchell Center Formal Entrance & Hosting Center Refresh, Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling, Washington, DC

GbOSS provided interior renovations for this \$205 K contract to carefully update finishes, ceiling tiles and lighting, as well as restroom updates within this historic structure. Existing millwork and wooden trim was left intact. Exterior work included updated electrical systems, new lighting fixtures and awnings. This project occured within the Anacostia Historic District at Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling.

GbOSS provided construction services for the installation of a retrofit branch circuit monitoring system for the original data center Power Distribution Units (PDU) in exisintg computer rooms. The monitoring system was installed in 40 PDUs. GbOSS provided coordination with and integration of the branch circuit monitoring system with the existing facility Power Management and Control System. Work was completed in an operational corporate data center and was coordinated in advance to eliminate impact to mission critical operations. GbOSS completed in February 2021 and received a Very Good Evaluation on Contractor Performance Assesment Rating.

Since 2018, GbOSS has been performing on this IDIQ JOC contract on a wide range of new construction/addition, renovation, and modernization task orders at Letterkenny Army Depot. GbOSS has been awarded 167 Task Orders and completed 150 task orders valued at over \$32 million during the life of the contract. GbOSS currently has 17 task orders in progress and valued at \$8.4 million.



Wage Grade Shop at National Conservation Training Center, US Fish & Wildlife Service, Shepherdstown, WV

GbOSS provided Design-Build services for a new pre-engineered metal building valued at \$2 M that serves as a hands-on skills training facility for maintenance professionals across the Fish & Wildlife Service. The 6,000 SF building features a maintenance shop with offices, conference room, kitchen, bathrooms, locker room, and heated shop area readily accessed by exterior overhead garage doors.



Building 1, 2nd Floor Renovation DOE National Energy Technology Lab, Albany, OR

GbOSS provided general construction services for this \$2.8 M renovation to convert the existing floor layout from a double load corridor of office and support space to a racetrack layout. Work provided for new offices, meeting/conference rooms, kitchenette, relocated ADA men's and women's toilet rooms and support spaces. New HVAC system serves the renovated spaces, and new lighting and electrical enhance the reconfigured spaces. A new automatic wet fire sprinkler system, new electrical room and a new data closet were added. The building was fully occupied while renovations occurred.
